

NOTES

- SUBS: Rolling Subs are used in ALL youth football.
- BACKPASS: Deliberately playing the ball to the Goal Keeper a backpass is NOT ALLOWED (note the word deliberately), at any age. If not
 intentional, then no offence is committed.
- THROW-INS: Not used in U7 U9 football, the 'dribble-in' or 'pass- in' is used instead.
- RETREAT LINE: In U7 10, when there is a goal kick, the players from the opposing team must retreat to the half-way line until the kick is taken.
- GOAL KICK: At all ages, goal kicks must be kicked from the ground.
- HEADING: At U7 U9 deliberately heading the ball is an offence punishable by an indirect free kick. The indirect free kick is taken at the point where the ball was deliberately headed, except where a player deliberately heads the ball within their own penalty area in this case the referee will stop the game and restart with an indirect free kick to the opposition from the nearest side line of the penalty area where the offence took place.
